The Project Implementation Unit for Khartoum New Interantional Airport (KNIA) and the public water purveyor State Khartoum Water Corp. agreed to develop a water supply schme for the White Nile west banks to service future KNIA and the surrounding regional development.

This water supply scheme includes the DN500 (20") Jebel Aulia White Nile Water Transmission Line (JAWN) starting at the Corp's Jewel Aulia water treatment plant on the White Nile east bank, pumping station, White Nile river crossing, the transmission line and the high point revervoir. It futher integrates two exsiting ground water wells and DN200 (8") transmission lines.
